A portlet is a visual container that presents a set of related information about an object. A ortlet can contain actions for users to perform and links to navigate to other parts of the ser interface. ortlets are specific to Dashboard/Homepage where they roll up information from the My Work

/ default, a user should be able to fit 3 portlets across a window size of 1366 x 768px, /ITHOUT any horizontal scrolling of the portlets. Avoid horizontal scrolling where possible, instead xpand the portlets to 2 per row if this can avoid horizontal scrolling. Ensure that the portlets quid across the window size nicely, so their size corresponds to the minimum width above.
